**PETROL (or diesel)** - Have you got enough? Do you know where to fill up? If you have an electric car, have you planned where to charge?



OIL - Check levels at least once a month



WATER - Check radiator and screenwash regularly



DAMAGE - Check wipers and lights for signs of wear and tear. Ensure windscreens, windows and lights are clear of ice and snow



**ELECTRICS** - Check lights, indicators and controls are working properly



RUBBER TYRES - Are they well inflated, legal, with good tread and free from damage?



YOU - Are you fit to drive? Have you slept well? Are you taking any medication that could make it unsafe for you to drive?

## GET READY TO GO!





Clear ice and snow from all windows so you can see clearly



Ensure lights are clean and number plates are clearly visible



Make sure the mirrors are clear and the windows are demisted thoroughly



Remove all snow that might fall into the path of other road users



If you are travelling longer distances, check the weather forecast for all travel days

PACK IN YOUR CAR BEFORE THE START OF WINTER:

First aid kit



Jump leads

Ice scraper and de-icer

Torch and spare batteries



Any regular medication

A shovel

Sunglasses (for glare from winter sun)
