

## CHANUKAH - FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS

Chanukah, the Festival of Lights, involves lighting one candle on a nine-branched Menorah over eight nights. The Menorah celebrates a miracle whereby a holy temple light (the Ner Tamid), which is never meant to go out, remained alight for eight days, on only one day's supply of oil. The eight candles of the Menorah commemorate this. Symbolic foods such as doughnuts and latkes cooked in oil are abundant during Chanuka to commemorate the miracle of the oil.
